BASIC PRINCIPLES


We will achieve our goals by undertaking the following:

- Establishing a resilient culture across Qatar Rail and its projects by effectively minimising the risk of disruption caused by security and emergency incidents.
- Ensuring the railway design incorporates the border, security and environmental protection necessary for railway operation, including liaison with the appropriate authorities on international control zones.
- Ensure compliance with applicable security and emergency preparedness legislation, standards and other requirements associated within our industry and region.
- Developing and implementing a comprehensive security and emergency management program comprising physical, technological, and operational components that together form a unified program.
- Ensure interagency cooperation and dialogue with relevant external organisations on security and emergency management matters to include police, intelligence services, Civil Defense, hospitals, and emergency medical services.

We will create a working environment characterised by a commitment to our Security and Emergency Preparedness culture objective, practices, and continual improvement. In this way we can work together so that our goal of Zero Harm is achieved.
